Cosmetic surgery without the suffering

In the USA the cosmetic surgery industry is worth over \$10 billion a year. And in 2014, over 14 million Americans had a cosmetic procedure. But luckily, many of these procedures can now be done without the need of a scalpel, anaesthetic, a surgeon or in an operating theatre as doctors develop new technologies which make these interventions far less painful. So if you've always been too scared of needles to have plastic surgery, that may no longer be a problem.

A new skin-tightening device that can be used to perform facelifts means that patients don't have to suffer any incisions, which can both massively reduce the risk of infections and reduce a patient's recovery time. For the rich and famous, where time is money, this is a huge bonus. But this new technology doesn't come cheap. In fact, a non-surgical facelift can cost as much as \$35,000 in New York.

For those patients looking to lose some weight and reduce their levels of fat, traditionally, liposuction was the answer. But a new technique called Liposonix has recently become available, which again doesn't require patients to go under the knife. According to Dr Doris Day, a New York based dermatologist, 'It's like liposuction, but it's a non-surgical approach. It uses high-density focus ultrasound to actually heat up and melt fat.' And how much would this procedure cost? About \$11,000 for a day's work.

As the technology becomes more widely available, and more doctors master these new techniques, it is likely that the currently astronomical prices will begin to fall, and more and more people will be turning to these new procedures in an ever-lasting bid to stay young looking. But the question will still remain: what is so wrong about growing old and looking your age?

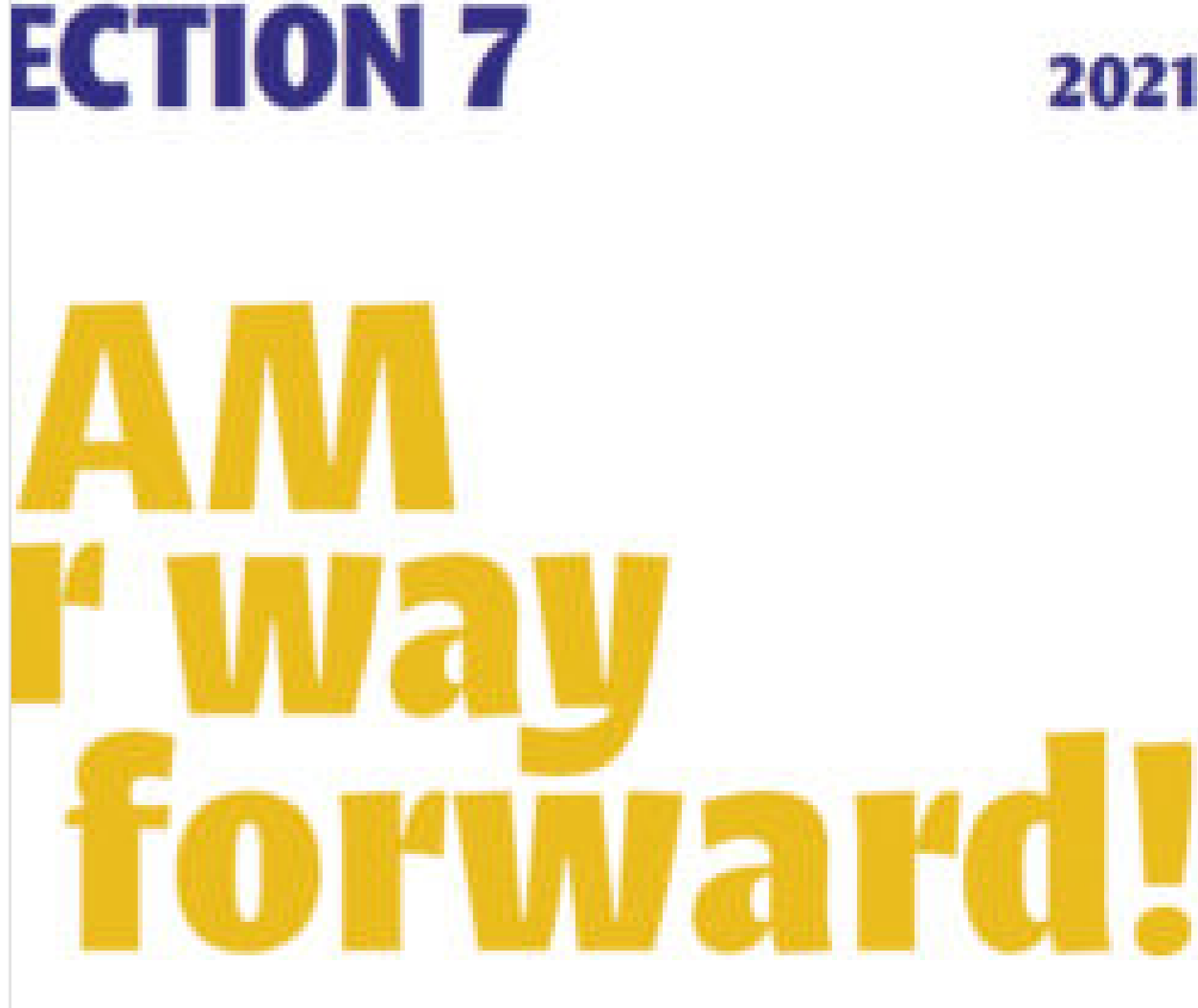
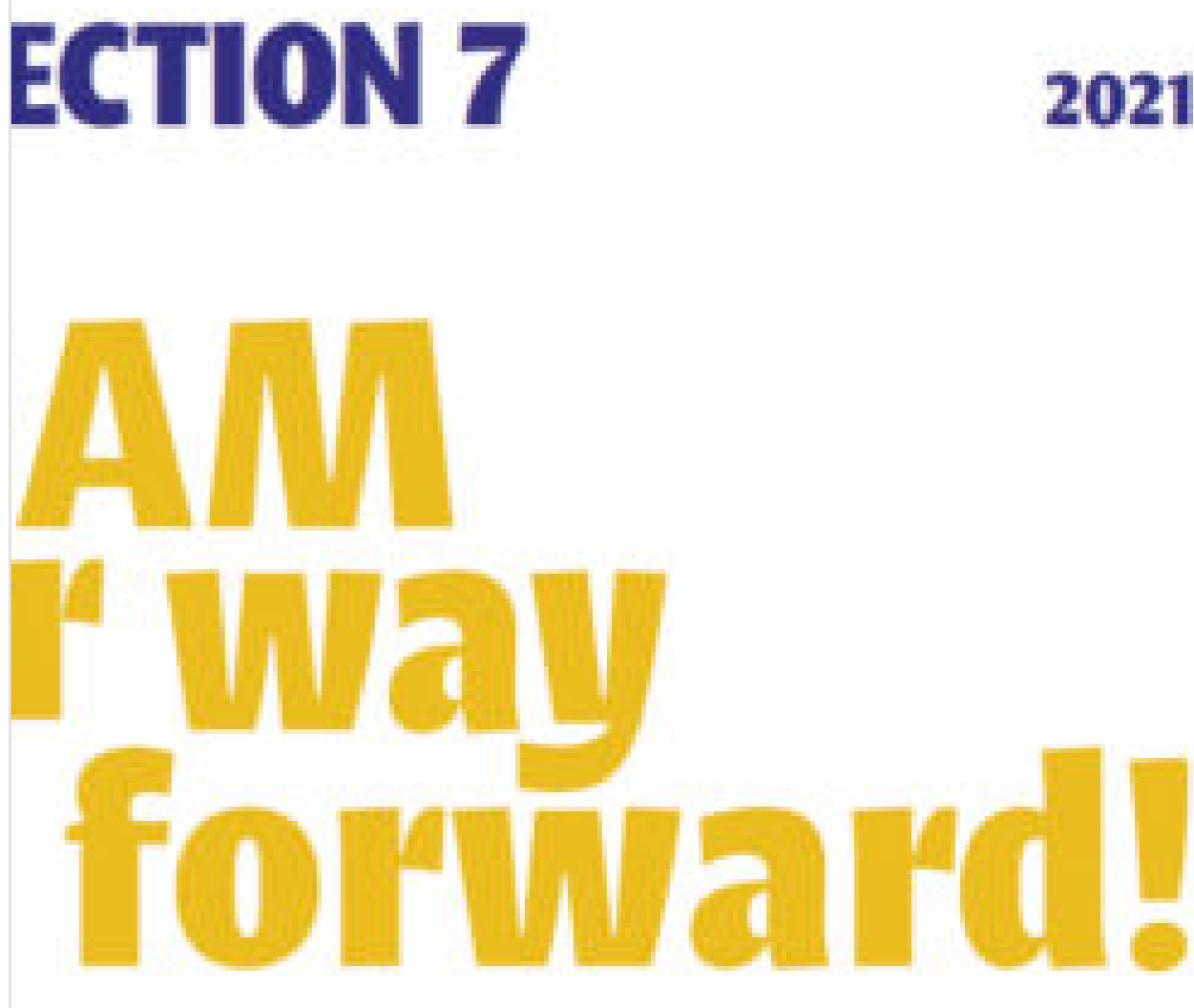
